#### Malcolm Imhoff FRPS ~ Chairman of the Jury

Malcolm Imhoff has been producing Audio-Visuals for over twenty years. He enjoys communicating his interests in travel, landscapes, mountaineering, and all sorts of music. He has developed a personal style in which excellence in photography, skill in the use of sound, and the creation of rhythm in the production, are interwoven to engage the emotions of the audience. With sequences such as "Carnival in Venice", "The Ascent of Mont Blanc", "Watch where you're putting your feet", "Matterhorn People", "The Spaghetti Tour", and "Trekking in Nepal", he has received many awards in both National and International Festivals. He is a Fellow of the Royal Photographic Society and serves on the RPS Audio-Visual Distinctions Panel.

"I am very honoured to be invited to be Chairman of the Judges at the National AV Festival and I am looking forward to working with my fellow Fellows, Eddie and Edgar, both experienced practitioners whose work and judgement I hold in high regard."

#### Edgar Gibbs FRPS DPAGB AV-AFIAP

It was when Edgar was studying civil engineering in the early 70s that he joined the photographic society. It fitted in well with his final year project which was in a subject called photo elasticity, where the results were recorded photographically. On leaving college he joined Gwynfa Camera Club, near where he lived and saw his first AV there not long after he married Linda. Since then they have both been hooked and he says he is very lucky they both enjoy the medium. Together they have attended many AV festivals at home and abroad. Edgar is particular keen on travelling to AV festivals in mainland Europe where a broader range of styles cab be seen. He and Linda ran the South Wales AV Group for 10 years and also served on the RPS International committee.

He loves the third image and feels that digital AV has to some extent removed this effect which now has to be created by Photoshop rather than the use of projectors. Nevertheless he has embraced the digital movement and is looking forward to seeing some innovative approaches when he judges the Nation AV Championships
