

RPS London, Street Workshop – Sign on Info

What do I need to bring on the day?

- Keep your kit small and light.
- Camera - small is preferable, but, bring what you have or are most confident using. Avoid large lenses, large bags and tripods.
- Lenses - a standard zoom of around 28-80mm* covers most normal focal lengths you will need. If you prefer prime lenses and can only bring one then the classic street lens is 35mm*. (* = Full Frame Equivalent).
- Film or Digital? - Entirely your choice, but I find digital more flexible and economical.
- Personal comfort and security - Walking shoes and weather protection according to the conditions on the day, whether it be sunny, cold or raining!. What you bring you will need to carry all the time so keep it to an absolute minimum and beware pickpockets - keep it zipped!
- Route – This will be described before the event but is usually well served by the A-Z and most smartphones. Please provide yourself with a map of the surrounding area for the shoot for your own reference.
- Disclaimer – You will be expected to have read and agreed to the RPS Risk Assessment as a condition of attending the workshop. This is standard for this kind of activity in a public place and you are expected to operate within the bounds of common sense for your own personal comfort and safety.
