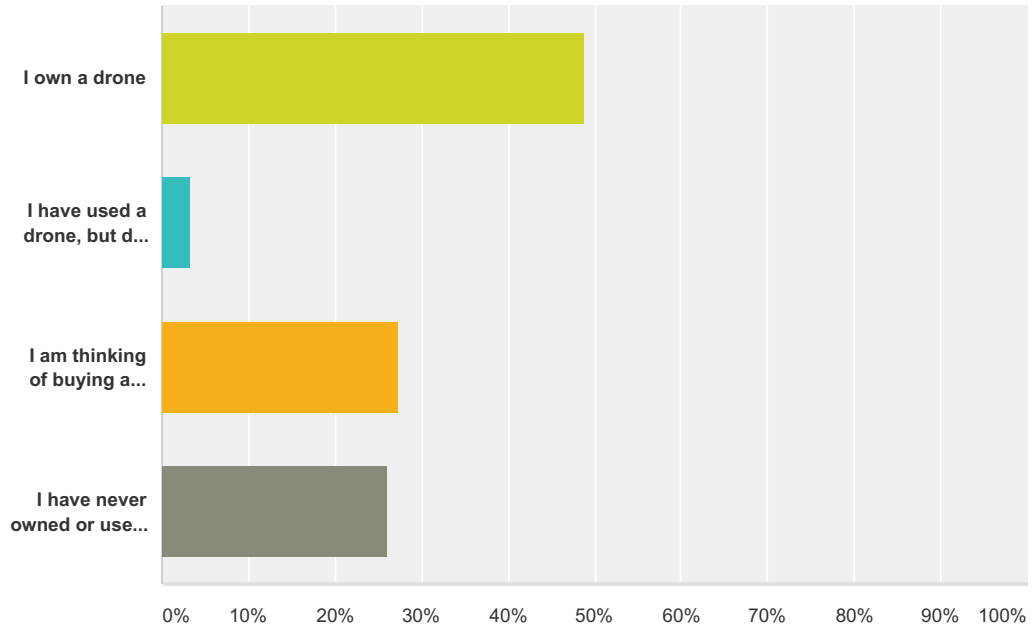


Q1 Which of the following statements apply to you?

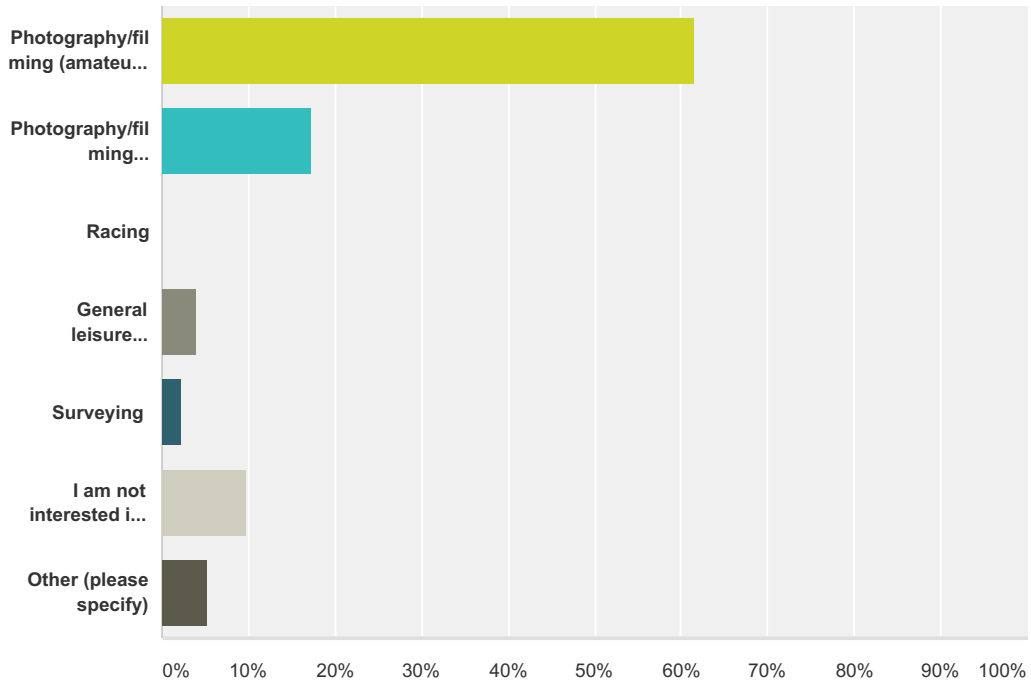

Q2 What would be your main reason for owning/using/buying a drone?

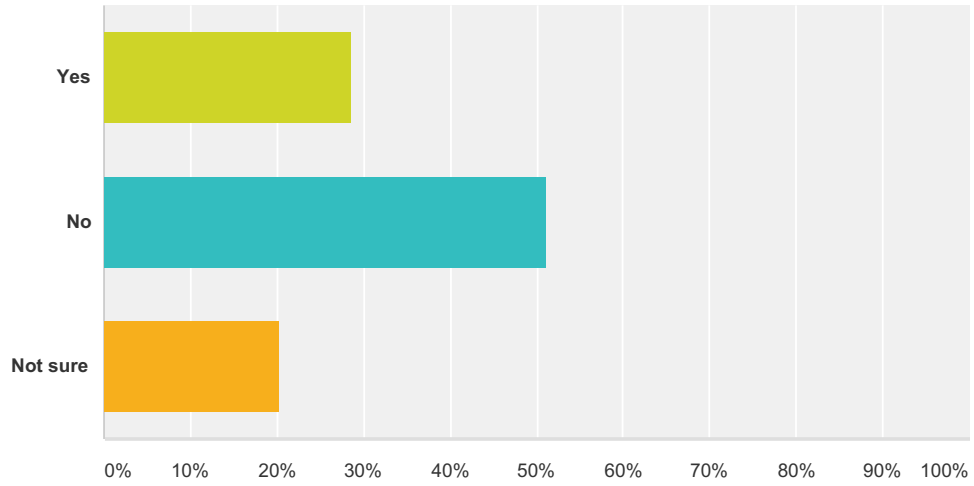

Q3 Would you agree with the statement: 'the current position on drone ownership and use is satisfactory and does not need changing'?

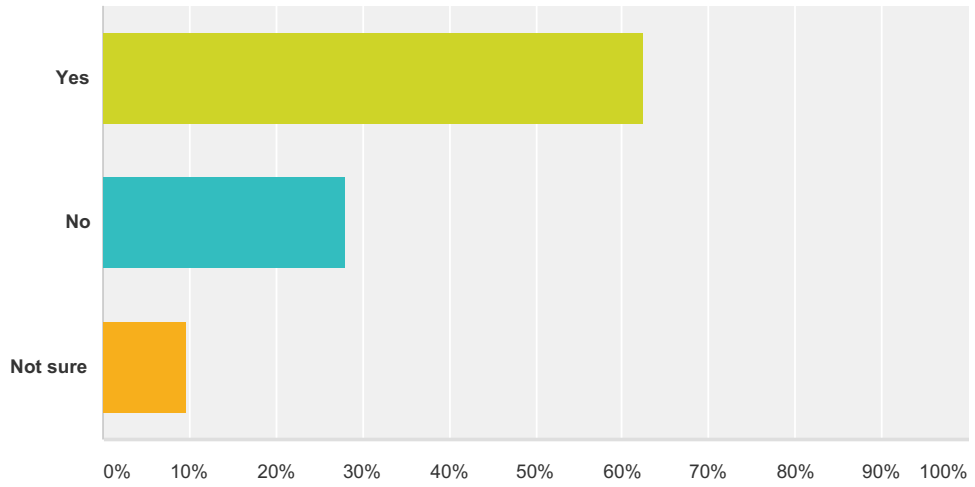

Q4 Do you think drones owners should be licensed?

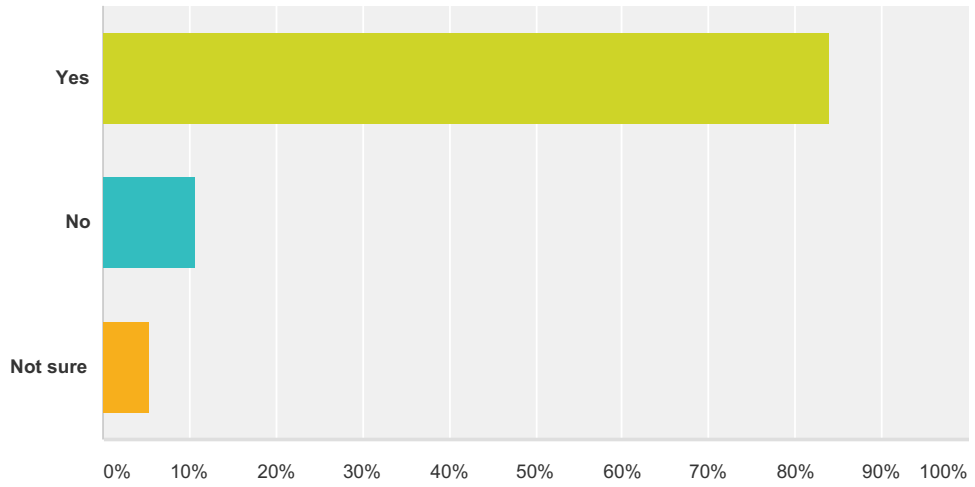

Q5 Do you think all drones should be registered to an individual?

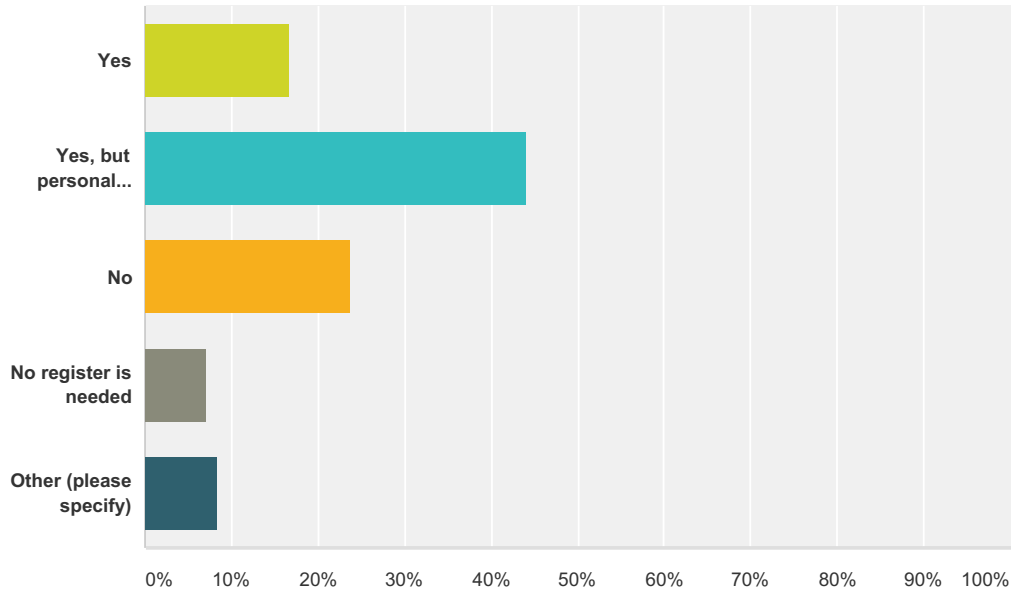

Q6 Should any register of drones or drone owners be publicly accessible?

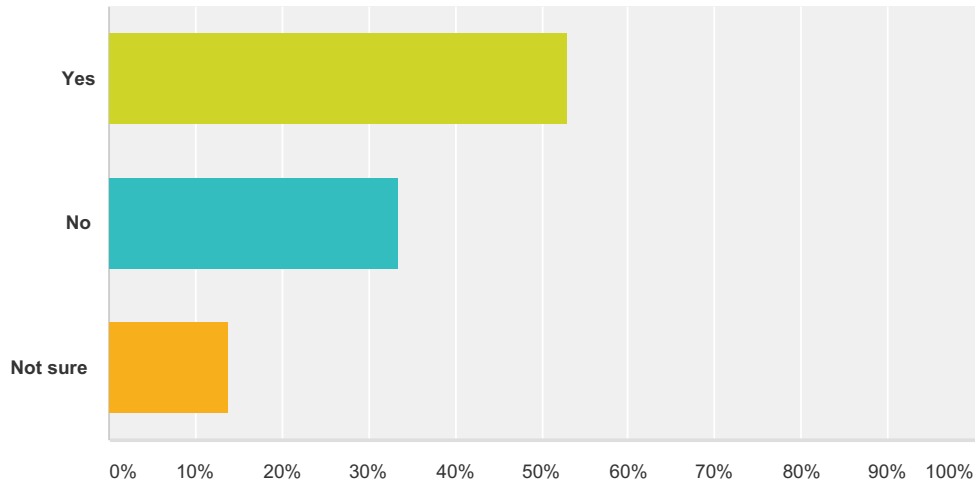

Q7 Do you think that drone owners should undergo mandatory training before they are allowed to fly their drones?

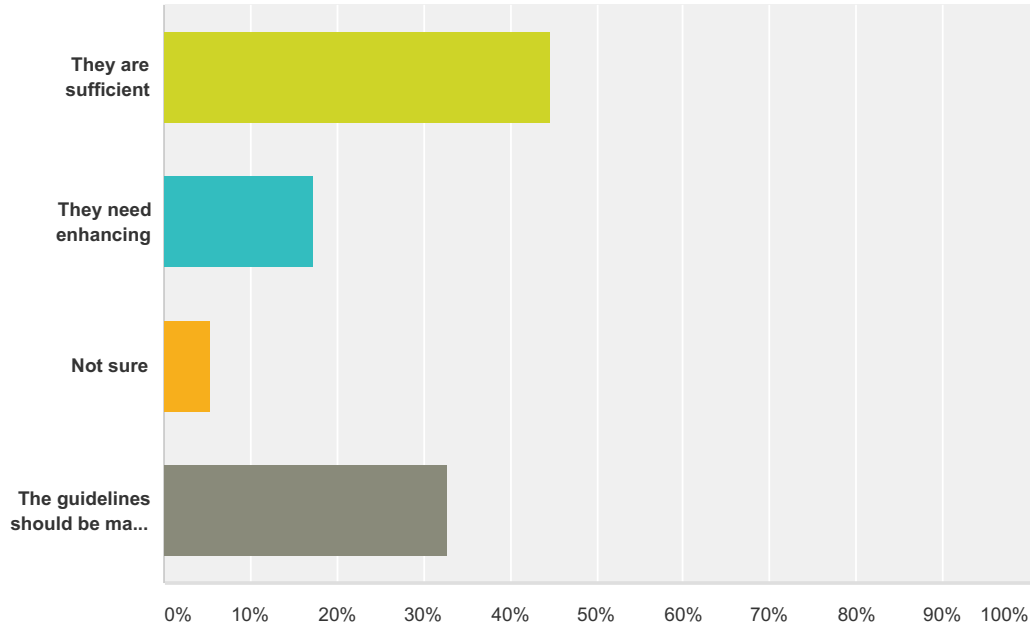

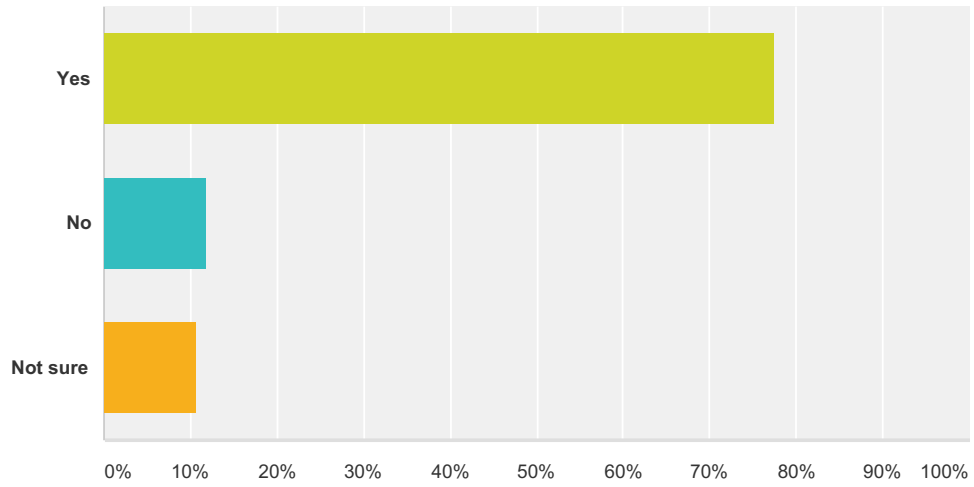

Q9 Should drone owners carry insurance in the event that their drone injures someone or damages property?

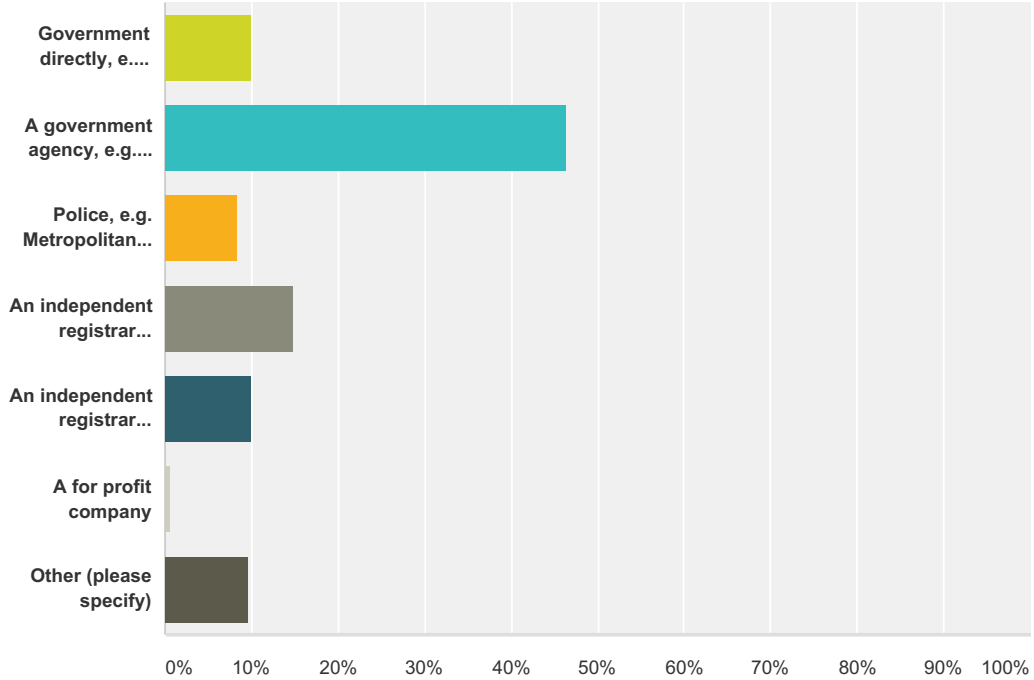

Q10 Assuming that registration of some type is introduced who do you think should be responsible for managing and policing it?

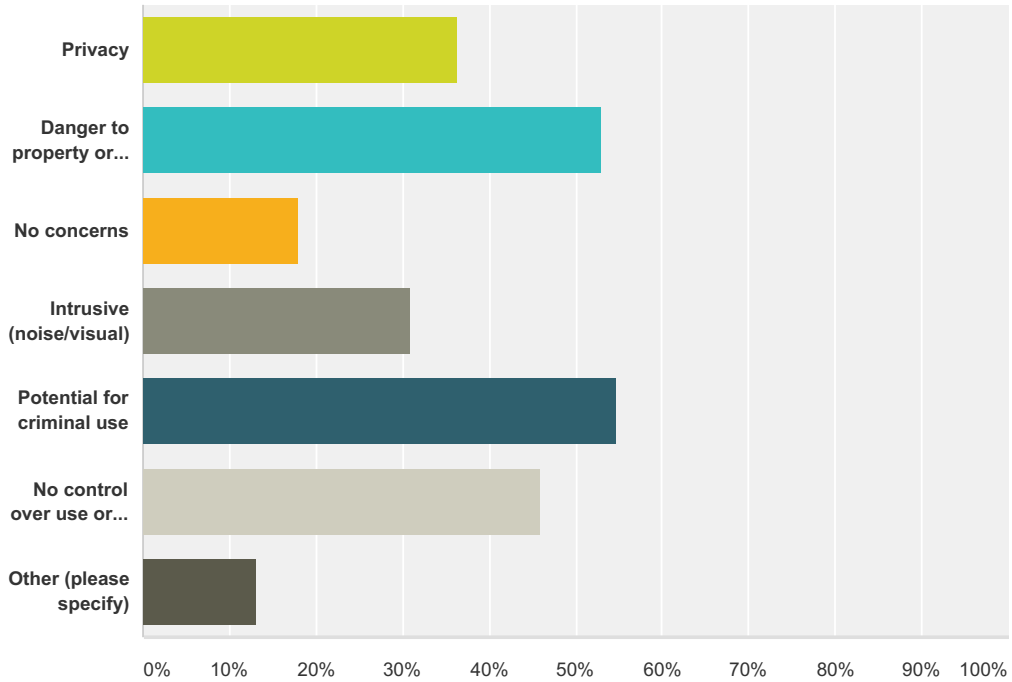
