General Information

This intersection lies in rural Somerset, 'somewhere in the middle' of grass field which is used for grazing sheep, and slopes gently to the south west near Wrantage, a hamlet within the parish of North Curry: it is about 4.5 miles as the crow flies, south-east (105degrees) of Taunton.

There is nothing permanent in the field to identify the position of the intersection: I determined it using a Garmin 'GPSmap 62s' GPS, to within an accuracy of +/- two metres, and marked it – for the sake of the photograph – with a small red flag. This can be seen in the submitted photograph in the lower left-hand corner of the picture.

Text Note explaining my location

My location when taking the photograph was about 60 metres south-east of the intersection.

I was facing north-west, looking towards and beyond the intersection, over pasture land leading up to the low ridge between Thornfalcon and North Curry

I was about 60 metres from the intersection

The intersection is marked by a small red flag, visible in the lower left hand third of the photograph.
