This should not be viewed as a barrier and under such circumstances, applicants are advised to contact the RPS CEO, Dan Jones at dan@rps.org in order that they can be connected to relevant Members, Groups, Regions or Chapters in order that sufficient support may be secured.

- Applications from RPS Members or non-Members with the required level of support of ten nominations (from RPS Members) will be reviewed by the RPS Nominations Committee (NomCom) as part of the election process whereby NomCom recommends to the electorate those applicants having the required skills, expertise and qualities deemed necessary to the effective operation of the Board.
- Applicants who were unsuccessful in becoming an Elected Trustee, and any applicants who are seeking to stand only for an Appointed Trustee position, will be considered by NomCom for an Appointed Trustee position on the RPS Board of Trustees once the election results are known and any gaps in skills and expertise have been determined. Notwithstanding any recommendation by NomCom, all Appointed Trustee positions are made at the sole discretion of the Board of Trustees.
