INTRODUCTION FROM THE FESTIVAL DIRECTOR

Welcome to the third edition of Festival News. Our plans are continuing to go well and I'd like to update you with the latest information, in particular about the venue for the event and how to book projection sessions and meals.

THE VENUE

The Royal Photographic Society 23rd International Audio Visual Festival 2018 will be held over the weekend of Saturday 22 September & Sunday 23 September 2018. The location for the Festival is The 1914 Centenary Hall, Dean Close Preparatory School, Lansdown Road, Cheltenham, Gloucestershire, GL51 6QS.

THE AUDIENCE VIEW

If you are coming to the Festival you will be able to enjoy viewing the AVs from the Hall's raked theatre, enhanced by the loan from Epson of a projector, which retails at around £7000, with the AVs projected onto a 16' by 9' screen.





SOUND FOR THE FESTIVAL

On the way back from the RPS AV Group Advisory Day, I was able to call in to ATC, the company that has loaned the stunning powered speakers used at previous RPS International AV Festivals. The Chief Executive was delighted to learn how much they were appreciated at the 2016 Festival and the impact they'd had on the Festival audience. He confirmed that he would be very pleased to loan them again for the 2018 Festival weekend. The speakers retail for about £14,000, so excellent sound is guaranteed.

RUNNING ORDER OF AVs TO BE SHOWN AT THE FESTIVAL

We have had 112 entries from 13 FIAP countries, which has meant that with the limited time available for projection over the Festival weekend, there has had to be a pre-selection process carried out by the Chair of the Jury. He has chosen 90 AVs to be shown over the Festival weekend and all entrants have been informed of the Chair of the Jury's decision. The Festival Timetable and Projection Sessions, showing the running order of AVs to be

shown at the Festival, will be posted on The RPS website www.rps.org/iavf on Thursday 6 September 2018.

JUST A COUPLE OF DAYS LEFT TO BOOK YOUR TICKETS FOR THE FESTIVAL

If you are you still thinking of coming to the Festival, and you haven't booked your tickets for the Projection Session and/or meals you have just a couple of days until the **closing date for booking, which is 23:59 p.m. on Sunday 9 September 2018**. Bookings for the Festival Dinner on the Saturday evening have been very popular. There is a limit to the numbers that can be accommodated for the Festival Dinner, but we do still have some availability. Tickets for the daily Projection Sessions can be purchased on the day at the Reception Desk, but cost slightly more than tickets booked in advance. Unfortunately, meals have to be pre-ordered by [9 September](#) to inform the Catering Service of numbers, but tea and coffee are included in the price of the session tickets.

The venue for the Festival is the 1914 Centenary Hall, Dean Close Preparatory School, Lansdown Road, Cheltenham, Gloucestershire, GL51 6QS UK.

The Festival weekend is an opportunity for you to see AVs from around the world whether you attend for one day or the whole weekend, and I look forward to seeing you at the Festival.
