

53N 1W, Nottinghamshire by Simon Hill FRGS HonFRPS

The intersection is to the south of Marlock Bridge, between Lowdham and Gunthorpe on the A6097 Lowdham Road, in the corner of a field S of a bend in Cocker Beck and on the edge of a small coppice of trees. The intersection is on private farmland so was photographed using a drone.

The closest accessible location was the end of a farm track, Cottage Pasture Lane, where a concrete bridge crossed the beck at SK 67291 45362. The bridge provided the take-off point and a short flight on bearing 200° directly to the intersection point avoided the Flight Restriction Zone of RAF Syerston, an operational station at which is based Number 2 Flying Training School and the RAF Central Gliding School. The photograph was taken with a very slightly oblique viewpoint from 53°0'0.2806" N 0°59'59.3594" W, therefore almost directly overhead of the intersection point which is at the bottom of the frame on the bare earth close to the trees.
