

The Photographic Angle and Royal Photographic Society Environmental Awareness Bursary 2021

The Royal Photographic Society in partnership with [The Photographic Angle](#) is offering a 1-year bursary to support a photographic project that will promote environmental awareness.

In addition to the funding you will also have the opportunity to have a practice and portfolio review on; your website; social media and networks; communication skills and a printed portfolio of images of a single series or a series edit up to 12 16x12" Ctypes with [Metro Imaging](#).

Applications are invited from anyone living or studying in the United Kingdom with a talent for taking photographs and an interest in the environmental concerns that we face today. The Society and the TPA have decided that this year we will be asking applicants to propose projects that are based in the UK. We feel that this will help with any remaining COVID 19 restrictions and go some way in addressing the environmental issues associated with long distance travel.

The bursary will provide £3000 to assist with travel expenses, photographic equipment and other project-related costs.

The closing date will be the 30 July 2021. We will notify the successful applicants by the end of August 2021.

We are looking for a creative interpretation of the subject as well as documentary and editorial photography.

The successful applicant will be expected to deliver a 500 word report and 6 images, 6 months into the project. The final report needs to be 1000 words with 10 images, along with an agreement to give a talk or workshop on their project at an RPS/TPA event.

If you wish to apply, please carefully read through the online application form and fill in each section.

Although this is a photographic bursary, it is important that you can express your objectives and outcomes in written form.

Please also give a clear breakdown on how you plan to spend the bursary, the time scale and what you plan to do with the work on completion.

Although your work will be published in the RPS Journal and TPA and RPS websites we will be looking for an applicant who has a clear idea of where and how they will use their images to get their messages across to as wide an audience as possible.

Applications will not be accepted via email.
