


A guide to editing your portfolio on the new RPS website

Logging in to edit your public portfolio

- 1) If you are not already on your profile page, just follow this link: <https://www.rps.org/member-portfolio/edit/>.

You may be asked to log in. (If you are having problems logging in, please review the information on this page: www.rps.org/new-website/.)

You will be greeted with a page that looks like this:



- 2) Click on the “*Edit your details ...*” link, circled in the example above.

Display name

- 3) You can edit your display name as shown below:

Display Name


Set display name

This changes your portfolio URL and how your name is displayed to RPS website users. Please write this as you would like it viewed e.g. Jan Smith ARPS - it will create the link correctly for you. Make sure there are no spaces at the end as they will appear as hyphens.
Example: rps.org/portfolio/1234/jan-smith-arps


⚠ Changing your display name also changes the URL used to view your portfolio. You will no longer be able to use the prior URL and must update anywhere you have it listed.

To other people, this will appear on your portfolio page, and in the url that links to your page as shown in the example below:



Privacy options


You have three privacy options for your portfolio: 1) Private (only you can see it), 2) Public (anyone can see it), 3) Member Only (only logged in RPS Members will be able to see it).






Uploading images

- 9) After clicking the :”*Edit gallery*” link the following page will appear and you need to press ‘Upload Images’. **You will have to load less than ten images at a time:**



When you load the images, you will be offered the option to add titles and other information.

- 10) If you choose to add titles/info, you will need to **press save after amending each image.** This will store your changes and give you the option to ‘Edit’ or ‘Delete’:



Adding images to your public profile


11) Now you have images saved in your gallery, you must choose which to show on your public portfolio by clicking, "Add to portfolio":



12) You can then select your images. When you do a small tick will appear in the top right of the picture:



13) When you are happy with your selections press 'Save Order':



Your images will now show on your profile page like this:



Please note that when you are looking at this page you will see the blue edit bar across the middle of it. If you want to see it without, test it in another browser without logging in with your profile set to 'public' (you can set this back to 'private' straight after if you prefer).

14) If you want to change the order of your images, start by selecting 'Reorder':



15) To change the order of the images, drag and drop them into the desired order (click and hold an image while you move it to your desired position), then press save:



Your new order will now be reflected on your portfolio page.


Changing your profile picture

If you edit your profile picture, it will show to other people if you have set this to be public or member only.

16) Go to <https://rps.org/my-rps-dashboard/> or click on your name at the top right of the screen which will give you the My RPS option.:



17) Then click, "Edit profile".



Thus will take you to you *Account settings* page.

18) Click on the picture place holder to upload an image:

19) Click "Save" at the bottom of the page.
