(FICS) was founded in the year 1956, the tape recorders being hardly available in their present form for amateurs. The federation comprises at the moment 10 national sound recording associations in Europe and 1 Overseas (Australia). The field of interests and activities, which was in the beginning confined to Sound recording, was soon extended to Diaporamas and to Video recording, which both at least to a certain extent are depending on good sound. To promote this "good sound" the FICS takes the patronate of similar international Festivals and offers the "JEAN THEVENOT" medal for Jean Thévenot, French, died a few year ago. He was a journalist and worked in French radiobroadcasting; was one of the founders and promotors of the Sound recording movement.

The major event this autumn is Norman Parkinson's 75th Birthday exhibition which provides a comprehensive look at his work over the last 50 years. It is a rare opportunity to see such a spectacular selection of this celebrated photographers work and an exhibition not to be missed. In the Kodak gallery we have the work of two women photographers coinciding with the first 'Spectrum Women's Photography Festival' which is being celebrated nationally. This stunning show combines the bright and ebullient work of Nancy Honey with the subtle pastel - like studies by Hope Kingsley, who is incidentally, a past member of the Society's staff.
