

Rules for the DI Digital Imaging Competition 2023/2024

July 2023

Open to all RPS Digital Imaging members, including overseas members.

Rounds 1 to 5 will have set subjects. Round 6 is the final.

1. Entering

Each entrant can submit up to three (3) images in any one round.

Images must have originated as photographs (image captures of objects via light sensitivity).

Images must have been taken within 6 months of the date of submission.

2. Image file requirements

Following are the mandatory requirements for the image files:

- a. **Size**: Images should be a minimum of 1080px on the shortest side.
- b. **Colour space:** The image should be in the sRGB colour space.
- c. Format: The files must be in JPEG format
- d. File size maximum: each image file to be uploaded must be no larger than 5MB.
- e. **Titles**: each image must have a title and must **not** include your name.
- f. **No watermarks**, titles or photographer's name/qualifications/Distinctions are to appear in a digital image.

3. How to enter

Prepare your images as above. Once submission opens, follow the onscreen instructions to submit your images on the competition page https://rps.org/di/di-competition.

4. Compliance

Digital Imaging reserves the right to request the original camera file or high resolution scan or RAW image file for authentication.

The competition organiser and the Digital Imaging Committee's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.

5. Copyright and reproduction

The copyright of all entries remains with the photographers.

The Digital Imaging Committee reserves the right to reproduce any entry (without fee) in connection with the competition.

6. Notification of results

Winning images from Rounds 1 to 5 will be displayed in the Round 6 folder and announced in the DI Online publication that follows the end of the round.

7. Acceptance of rules

Submission of an entry will be taken as acceptance of the entry rules.
