The intent of this group is to interpret our set themes without necessarily taking the literal interpretation.

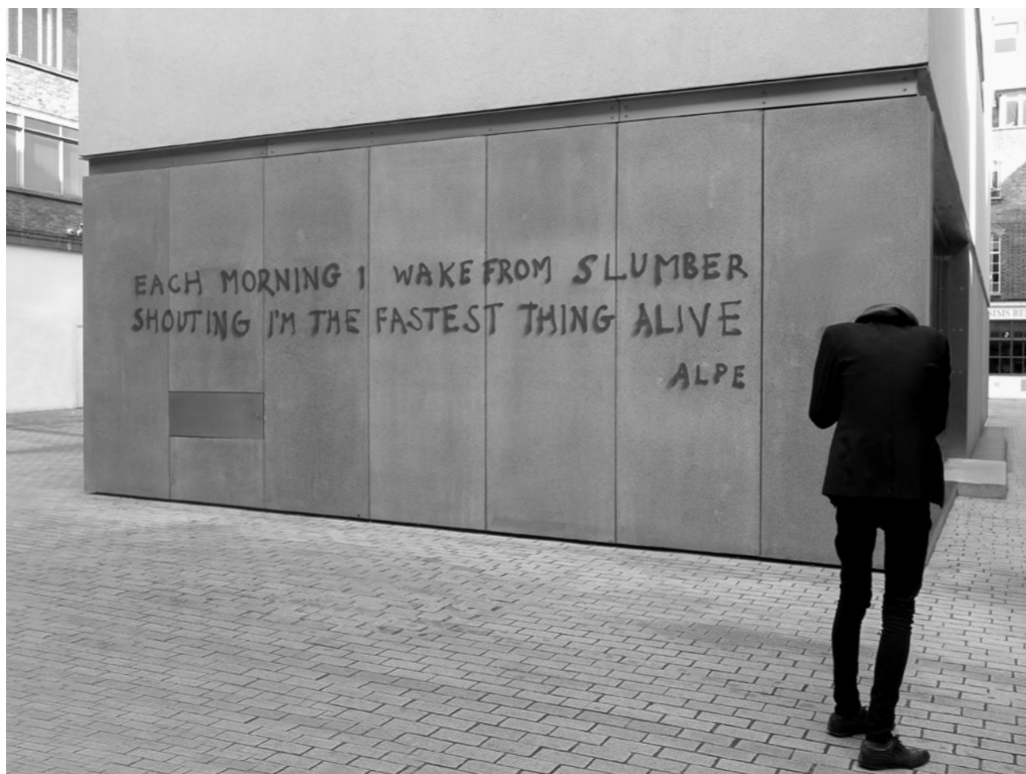

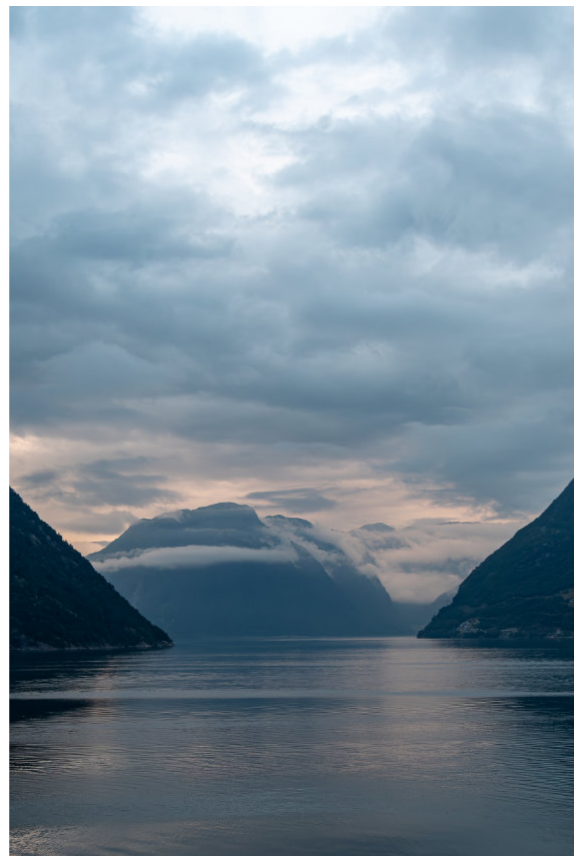


Guest exhibitors

This catalogue has been compiled since the new terms of reference were imposed.

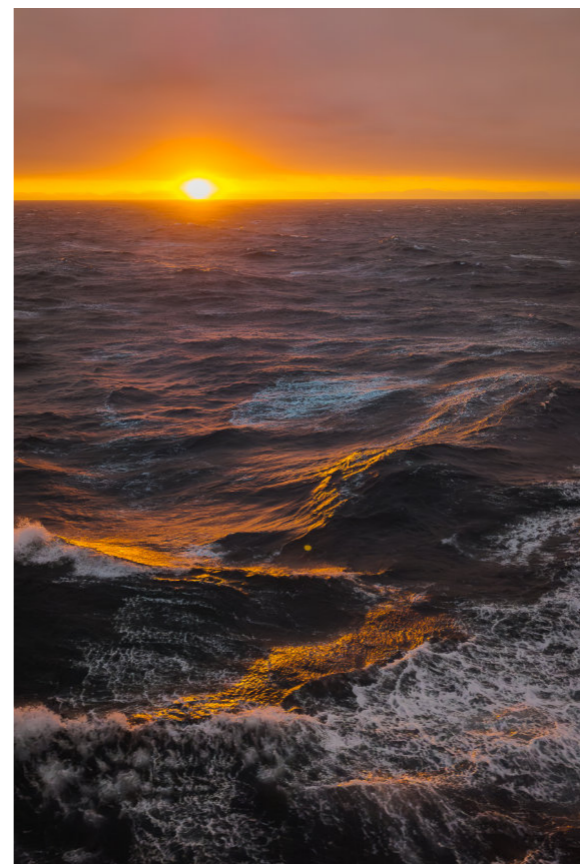
