

52N 0, Hertfordshire by Richard Burn

52N 0E is in the middle of a solar farm just outside Barkway, an historic and picturesque village in North Hertfordshire. I gained access to the location via a narrow road leading from the centre of the village, which then became a (rather muddy at the time of my visit) public footpath. It's impossible to see the exact point of intersection due to the solar panel density. This image was taken at 52.0021N 0.0034E, which is a few hundred yards north-west of the intersection.

It was impossible to ignore the high level of security surrounding the solar farm, especially the electrified fences and the large number of CCTV cameras; I had an almost dystopian feeling of "big brother is watching" hence the monochrome image.
